Background

- During the launch of The Fourth Heritage Initiative on 12th Sept, 2022 at the Uganda National Theatre, the paper *Mindshift 2090* was also announced and published on the website <u>www.4thheritage.com</u>. The paper builds on the foundational writings of the books *The Fourth Heritage* and *Beyond the Fourth Heritage* and the paper *The EDISAC Framework*. The hashtag #Mindshift2090 was also rolled out the same day on Twitter (now known as X).
